#### **FACTS**

- 5 million cases of meningitis a year.
- **300,000 deaths** from meningitis a year.
- 1 in 5 people with bacterial meningitis die.
- 1 in 5 people with bacterial meningitis have serious after-effects.
- Meningitis can kill in hours.
- **Anyone**, **anywhere** can be affected.

## THE IMPORTANCE OF VACCINES

- The most effective method of prevention.
- Meningitis vaccines prevent tens of thousands of deaths a year.
- Vaccines protect those around you, including:
  - Young children and infants
  - Older people
  - People with compromised immune systems
- Multiple vaccines are needed for protection against different types of meningitis. Speak to your local healthcare provider to see which vacines are available.

#### **AIMS**

- 1. Reduce cases and deaths.
- 2. Prevent epidemics.
- 3. Improve support and advocacy.

#### **SYMPTOMS**

- Fever
- Rash
- Headache Seizures
- Vomiting
  Muscle and
- Drowsy
- neck pain
- Confusion Dislike of bright lights

Symptoms can be hard to detect and fast to develop. If you suspect meningitis, seek urgent medical attention.

### **AFTER-EFFECTS**

The disease leaves 1 in 5 people with an impairment:

- Cerebral palsy
- Brain injury
- Depression
- Organ damage
- Hearing loss
- Sight loss
- Limb loss
